June is Brain Injury Awareness Month

What is a brain injury?

A brain injury is any trauma that leads to injury of the brain. Everyday activities such as driving a car, riding a bicycle or playing sports can result in a brain injury.

Why should I be concerned about a brain injury?

Brain injury is the number one killer and disabler of people under the age of 45.

Men are twice as likely as women to suffer a brain injury. Brain injuries can happen anytime, anywhere and to anyone.

Can brain injuries be prevented?

Most of the serious brain injuries can be prevented by wearing a helmet.

What are the effects of a brain injury?

The effects of a brain injury include:

- memory loss
- impaired reasoning skills
- paralysis of one or more limbs
- loss of vision
- loss of hearing
- loss of smell
- difficulty communicating
- headaches
- seizures
- increased mood swings
- vomiting
